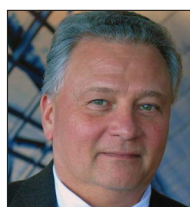

- **Provisioning alerts via SNMP traps:** With the help of this feature, you have the option to detect an alert, construct an SNMP message based on the alert, and send it out via an SNMP trap. This way, you'll be better equipped to detect a message pattern change in your databases, making it easier to move from one ClearPath® level to the next by reducing the effort needed to identify and change AMS databases.
- **Alert Policy import/export:** Built to function as a complement to the import/export functionality that exists in Operations Sentinel today, this new feature enables you to import and export the Alert Policies configuration, giving you additional ways of backing up the critical data related to this configuration.

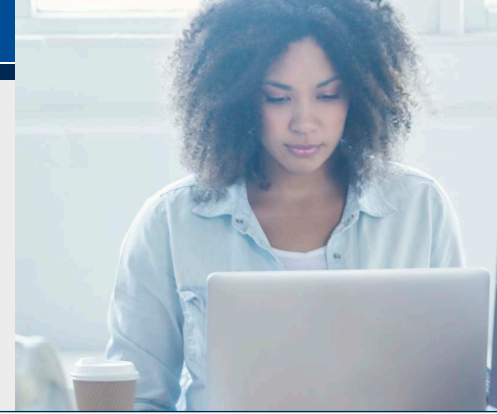

We're proud to announce the availability of Enterprise Output Manager 13.0!

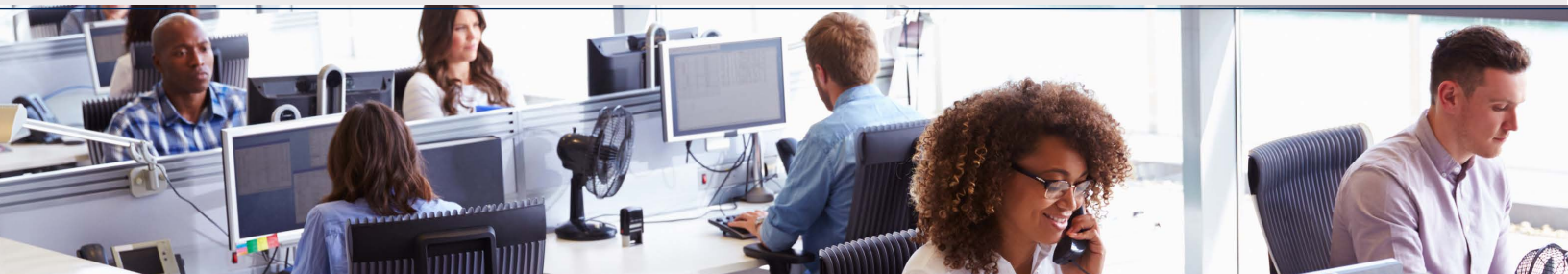

- **Web Assistant enhancements:** We've updated the Web Assistant in Enterprise Output Manager 13.0 with a number of important enhancements, including the ability to integrate it with any application that understands RESTful services. With the help of this integration, you can develop a custom user interface for the Web Assistant. In addition, the Web Assistant gives you the flexibility to select multiple files in the File Finder Search Result page and download them as a ZIP file. And, you'll also be able to identify any customizations added to the Web Assistant database and preserve them during an Upgrade or Load operation.

ClearPath OS 2200 Application Discovery in a Few Clicks



Founded in 1978, Formula Consultants Inc. (FCI) is a software development and consulting firm that works closely with IT organizations to understand the issues and goals they're facing and devises a custom-built solution to address these needs.

It's with this approach in mind that FCI recently released a new tool aimed at helping ClearPath OS 2200 shops tackle a common challenge: locating, identifying, and accessing valuable content on physical and virtual enterprise storage.

Called Enterprise Storage Pundit (ESP-Dorado), the tool features a graphical dashboard that allows you to monitor all aspects of your disk and tape assets. Its interactive charts reveal dynamic and customizable file, element, and tape lists, and can be drilled into to display source code or interact with Unisys Demand editors or the ClearPath OS 2200 IDE *for Eclipse™* to edit the source code.

It also includes a search engine feature that supports system-wide content discovery through the use of keywords and filter criteria, accelerating application development, discovery, and maintenance. It also helps new members of your team jump-start their productivity by enabling them to view application information in a modern, intuitive, industry-standard format and drill down from files to code and run scripts.

ESP-Dorado makes this possible by providing:

- **An OS 2200 Agent** that captures OS 2200 disk and tape activity and forwards it to the Repository Server for near-time maintenance processing
- **Collector Services** that harvest and maintain a record of OS 2200 host assets and work with the OS 2200 Agent to provide an organized version of the original information

Beyond these core capabilities, ESP-Dorado includes additional management features that make it easy to:

- Bookmark findings for easy recall
- Create tasks with associated bookmarks for workload dissemination
- Export or print list information
